#### Notes Regarding Holy Day Mass Music:

1) The congregation should know all of the hymns listed. However, you cannot assume that people will carry hymnals during the procession around the building. If an alternate hymn must be used (don't swap unless *absolutely* necessary) the song should be well-known and easily sung!

2) Be aware that once you exit the building, your voices will die away rapidly. Musicians should process BEHIND the congregation (or at least near the back) so that their voices will carry over the top of the crowd in front of them. Further, you will need to project your voice to a much greater extent and use your diaphragm/chest muscles to support your tone. Don't scream, just sing really loudly, and if you start to lose your voice, don't strain. Damage is easily done but not easily healed once present!
